

Concern & Objectives

This training concerns pilots who wish to act as SFI(A) (Synthetic Flight Instructor) AIRBUS A320.

The aim of this course is to give the necessary assets to the applicant to ensure a sufficient control of theoretical knowledge and various practices adapted to the ground and simulator trainings to be able to assume the privileges of a SFI(A). The applicant receives a training of basic teaching methods, which is implemented during briefings, debriefings, and simulator sessions.

Prerequisites

Any applicant for a first SFI(A) certificate must:

- Hold a CPL, MPL or ATPL pilot license on the applicable aircraft category,
- Have completed the proficiency check for the issue of the specific aircraft type rating in a FFS representing the applicable type (A320), within the 12 months preceding the application,
- At least 1 500 hours flight time as a pilot on multi-pilot airplanes, as applicable,
- Have completed, as a pilot or as an observer, within the 12 months preceding the application, at least:
 - 3 route sectors on the flight deck of the applicable aircraft type; or
 - 2 line-orientated flight training-based simulator sessions conducted by qualified flight crew on the flight deck of the applicable type. These simulator sessions shall include 2 flights of at least 2 hours each between 2 different aerodromes, and the associated pre-flight planning and de-briefing.

Training programme

THEORETICAL TRAINING	25H00 (Teaching and learning)
TECHNICAL TRAINING	12H00 (for 2 trainees). Revision of technical knowledge, the preparation of lesson plans and the development of classroom/simulator instructional skills
SIMULATOR TRAINING	On Full Flight Simulator (FFS) level D 12H00 with 7h30 Briefing/Debriefing
TOTAL DAYS OF TRAINING:	9 days (without AoC)

Assessment of Competence (AoC)

The applicant will have to perform, under the supervision of a TRE(A) or a SFE(A), 03H00 hours of Full Flight Simulator training of type rating of the considered aircraft, in compliance with AMC1 FCL.935.
